Dear Parent/ Guardian

At Henley Bank High School we will ensure that homework is impactful and consistent. Our homework is devised to ensure students at Henley Bank have a home learning strategy that compliments their efforts in the classroom and ultimately supports their progress.

All pupils will be set the following:

## In English:

Students will be completing weekly homework online through Bedrock Learning, which focuses on building new vocabulary that they can then use to access a range of texts across all subjects. Each pupil will be given a login and be expected to complete 1 hour and 30 minutes worth of tasks and lessons across the week. These tasks will be generated automatically based on their initial assessment. ## In Maths:

Students will be completing 5 tasks per week on <a href="https://example.com">hegartymaths.com</a>. If any scores are less than 90% pupils are required to watch the video in full and re-attempt the task to the best of their ability. All questions and answers must be written in pupil's homework books. ## In Science:

Complete the Educake Quiz set by their teacher to at least 85%. These can be accessed online, each pupil has an individual login. The reason for our initial focus on Maths, English and Science being set is to support our student's abilities in the core skills of literacy, numeracy and problem solving which are critical for progress in all subjects. It also aids the development of a strong independent work ethic which benefits them into KS4 and beyond.

Students will have their homework recorded weekly in each subject. Where homework has not been completed, students will be set an hours detention for the next day. In such cases parents will be communicated with via text. The first homework will be set the week beginning September 14<sup>th</sup> and collected in the week beginning September 21<sup>st</sup>.



Students will be set homework for the subjects on the days listed below. The date for submitting each piece of homework will be on the same day a week later, when the next item will be set:

Maths – Friday English – Thursday Science - Monday
