Re: Henley Bank High School Homework Policy

Dear Parent/Carers

At Henley Bank High School we will ensure that homework is impactful and consistent. Our homework is devised to ensure students at Henley Bank have a home learning strategy that compliments their efforts in the classroom and ultimately supports their progress.

All students will be set the following:

In English:

Students will be completing weekly homework online through Bedrock Learning, which focuses on building new vocabulary that they can then use to access a range of texts across all subjects. Each student will be given a login and be expected to complete 60 minutes of tasks and lessons across the week. These tasks will be generated automatically based on their initial assessment. In Maths:

Students will be completing 60 minutes per week of Maths practice on sparx.co.uk. All of the tasks will be listed on the student dashboard when they login with each question having a supporting video should students need help. Students are also encouraged to complete extra tasks via the 'optional' tab. Rewards will be given to those students who go above and beyond. In Science:

Complete the Seneca Task set by their teacher. All parts of the task need to be completed until green (80% +). This can be accessed online, each student has an individual login. Parents can also create a Seneca account to monitor homework at https://senecalearning.com/en-GB/parents. Students will have their homework recorded weekly in each subject. Where homework has not been completed, students will be set a 55-minute detention according to the table below. Parents will be informed via MCAS.

This first homework will not carry a sanction as it is an opportunity to check that all students are able to log-on and complete their homework and iron out any snags. Students will be set homework for the subjects on the days listed below. The date for submitting each piece of homework will be on the same day a week later, when the next item will be set:
