Re: Year 10 end of term assessments

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the mid-point of the academic year, students will be getting ready for assessments in each of their subjects. These assessments will take place in class and will be based on the curriculum the students have covered this academic year. Students will be assessed in all subjects that they study with the exception of core PE and core RS. Students will only receive one grade for English rather than a separate grade for English language and literature.

The purpose of these assessments is to support teachers, students, parents and carers in understanding the progress students have made in each of their subjects and how to continue to improve. The assessments will also help us inform class sets in English, mathematics and science. It will also provide students with vital preparation for their first set of formal mock examinations which will take place in the Summer.

All students have been given knowledge organisers and quiz booklets which cover the key subject content that they will be assessed on and are a fantastic tool in supporting students to revise. Students have been taught the best revision strategies in their weekly DEEP sessions and they should be revising by self-quizzing, either using their quiz book or by making flashcards of the key information. Ms Bowers has produced this helpful video, which summarises the best ways for students to revise.
