What is the Year 10 History Homework Policy?

SENECA is an educational website designed to test knowledge recall and key concepts that have already been taught. As such it is designed to *support* learned content, not *teach* new content.

Students will be assigned to their online class, where they can complete step by step questions based on the on-screen information. See images as an example.

Students can go at their own pace and see the progress they make.


Teachers will set approximately between 40-60 mins worth of content per week.

Enforcing the Law in the Early Medieval Period

In the absence of an official police force, local communities policed themselves. The communities had a number of different methods to do this; tithings, the Hue and Cry and local constables.




Constables

- Well respected men in the village would be expected to take on the role of Constable.
 - This would usually be a local landowner or well-respected tradesman.
- They would be expected to take the role for one year and the main responsibility was to keep the peace in their spare time.
- They would need to keep an eye for crimes being committed and lead the Hue and Cry when necessary.
