As we approach the spring term our Year 10 students are working hard in preparation for their mid-year assessments. These assessments will take place in class and will be based on the curriculum the students have covered so far this academic year.

The purpose of these assessments is to support teachers, students, parents and carers in understanding where students are in each of their subjects and how to continue to improve. The assessments will also help us in informing class sets in English, mathematics, science and languages.

This week, all students will receive knowledge organisers and quiz booklets which cover the key subject content that they will be assessed on and are a fantastic tool in supporting students to revise. Students have been taught the best revision strategies in their weekly DEEP sessions and they should be revising by self-quizzing, either using their quiz book or by making flashcards of the key information.

If students misplace their copy of the knowledge organisers, they will be able to ask their Head of Year for a new one and they will also be made available online.

The dates for the assessments are included with this letter. The majority of assessments will run between Wednesday 22nd January and Friday 7th February.
