RE Y7 Pantomime Trip 2025 - Robin Hood and his Merry Men- Thursday 11th December 2025

As part of our Legacy Ladder programme, I would like to invite your child to attend our annual Pantomime Trip to the Everyman Theatre, Cheltenham. This year the Pantomime is Robin Hood and his Merry Men. This is a chance for students to visit a local theatre and be part of a unique British tradition. They will also be learning about Pantomime in their Performing Arts lessons and this will give the students a chance to see a professional example of the techniques they have been learning about.

The trip will take place on **Thursday 11th December**. We will leave school, via coach, at the end of period 4 and we will **return to school for 4:30pm**. Students will need to be in school uniform and will attend lessons as usual until period 4. Should they wish to bring their own sweets for the show, they are welcome to as this will be cheaper than buying them at the theatre. We will ask that they use a plastic container with a lid for the sweets to reduce the sound for the cast and crew of the show. They may wish to bring a little money for an ice cream in the interval but they are rather expensive so they may perhaps prefer to bring their own snacks. **Students will require a packed lunch on this day.**
