Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that your child will participate in the first Legacy Ladder event for Year 10, by visiting the Gloucester History Museum on **Monday 17th November, during the school day.**

All students will have roll-call as normal, and will be back at Henley Bank High School by 3pm, so normal transport plans still apply.

This is a great opportunity for students to explore the heritage and history of Gloucester through the different eras in a way that they may not have done before. We are also incredibly lucky to be able to visit the Eastgate Chamber, to see the remains of the original Roman fortifications that Gloucester was built on.

Cost

The trip will be fully funded from the Legacy Ladder contributions. If you are yet to contribute towards the Legacy Ladder, we would appreciate it if you could do so as soon as possible. All contributions are payable via the Clubs section of the MCAS (MyChildAtSchool) app.

Food

Students will be in school for break and lunchtime, so there are no additional requirements for packed lunches. (Group 3 will have an early lunch at 12:30pm prior to leaving for the museum.)

Uniform

Students are expected to wear uniform as per usual: there will be no need for a change of clothes. However, please ensure your child has a raincoat, in case of rainy weather. We also recommend that your child brings a bag and a water bottle. Students will not be allowed to go shopping for food/drink.

Itinerary

Students will travel to the museum by coach, and will start with a tour of the museum, with a fact-finding sheet to complete, and will then be taken into the Eastgate Chamber, before returning to school.

There will be 3 different groups visiting the museum at different times:

Group 1 - 10BGY & 10SCE: from 9:05am - 11:00am

Group 2 - 10RJS & 10KSE: from 11:00am - 1:00pm

Group 3 - 10MFR & 10DBR: from 1:00pm - 2:55pm

Students will be grouped according to timetables and classes. There will be 3 separate groups attending the museum throughout the day.
