Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Legacy Week in July, we have a wonderful opportunity to take a trip to on **Wednesday 8th July**. This is a trip is for Year 9 students only.

We are booked into the **Natural History Museum** from 11:15am where we will explore some of the exhibitions there. This trip has been organised to support students' learning in science, particularly topics related to biology, geology, and the natural world. The museum offers a wide range of interactive exhibits that will enhance students' understanding and bring classroom learning to life.

Please can students arrive at Henley Bank no later than **8.15am** as we will be **departing school shortly after this time** and **returning to school approximately 6:30pm**.

Students will travel by coach and will be supervised by members of school staff throughout the day. Please ensure that they wear **school uniform** for this trip and bring with them a packed lunch as there will be no time/place to purchase food. A packed lunch will be provided for those students who are entitled to free school meals. Students will need to bring a refillable water bottle and may take sweets/snacks for the journey on the coach. Depending on weather, students may need sunscreen or a coat. Please make a judgement call on the morning of the trip.

Students will be allowed to bring mobile phones but will only be allowed to use them when instructed to do so by members of staff. Students will have the opportunity to take a bit of spending money if they wish to get anything from the Museum gift shop. We suggest no more than £20 and students will be responsible for their own money.
