Dear Parents and Carers,

Ahead of the England lockdown that begins tomorrow on Thursday 5th November, the Government have just released guidance which begins first thing tomorrow morning. Below are the aspects that impact our students within school.

Students must wear a face covering (mask or visor) at all times except when they are in lessons, eating or drinking. This includes during roll call, if in APC, or if working in the learning hub. They must wear a face covering (mask or visor) at both break and lunchtime except when eating or drinking.

If a student is unable to wear a face covering for whatever reason, please email their head of year explaining the reason why as this will be dealt with on an individual basis.
