**Re: Online Curriculum for Year 10**

I would like to start you by thanking you for all your support with the student's home learning. I am writing to you to inform of some changes that we are making to the way that we set year 10 online work and how this will allow us to further support students when they learn remotely.

From Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January, year 10 student's work will be set through Google classrooms, students are familiar with this platform, however if they need any help accessing Google classrooms they should contact Mr Phelps on the email address at the bottom of this letter.

Google classrooms will allow the teachers to set students bespoke work to their class, as well as to monitor work, provide support via email or telephone and provide students with feedback on their work. This will ensure that our year 10 students receive an excellent remote provision.

From Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January, students will follow their normal school timetable, meaning that they will have 5 lessons of work daily, which will also include a tutor time reading video that will be sent via email. All lessons should take students the same length of time as they would in a normal school day. To further support the student's learning, they will continue to receive their weekly homework tasks.

Teachers will be available to support the students during their normal lesson time, for example if the lesson is a period 2 the class teacher will be available for the students between 10am and 11 am. As a school we also appreciate the need for flexibility with remote learning so students are able to email their teachers outside of the lesson times, however responses to these emails may not be immediate.

All year 10 students will receive a copy of their timetable in an email, as well as a guide to completing their work on Google classrooms.
